Announcement to Zechariah

THE GOSPEL

Since many have undertaken to set down an orderly account of the events that have been fulfilled among us, just as they were handed on to us by those who from the beginning were eyewitnesses and servants of the word, I too decided, after investigating everything carefully from the very first, to write an orderly account for you, most excellent Theophilus, so that you may know the truth concerning the things about which you have been instructed.

In the days of King Herod of Judea, there was a priest named Zechariah, who belonged to the priestly order of Abijah. His wife was a descendant of Aaron, and her name was Elizabeth. Both of them were righteous before God, living blamelessly according to all the

commandments and regulations of the Lord. But they had no children, because Elizabeth was barren, and both


were getting on in years.

Once when he was serving as priest before God and his section was on duty, he was chosen by lot, according to the custom of the priesthood, to enter the sanctuary of the Lord and offer incense. Now at the time of the incense offering, the whole assembly of the people was praying outside. Then there appeared to him an angel of the Lord, standing at the right side of the altar of incense. When Zechariah saw him, he was terrified; and fear overwhelmed him. But the angel said to him, "Do not be afraid, Zechariah, for your prayer has been

heard. Your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you will name him John. You will have joy and gladness, and many will rejoice at his birth, for he will be great in the sight of the Lord. He must never drink wine or strong drink; even before his birth he will be filled with the Holy Spirit. He will turn many of the people of Israel to the Lord their God. With the spirit and power of Elijah he will go before him, to turn the hearts of parents to their children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the righteous, to make ready a people prepared for the Lord." Zechariah said to the angel, "How will I know that this is so? For I am an old man, and my wife is getting on in years." The angel replied, "I am Gabriel. I stand in the presence of God, and I have been sent to speak to you and to bring you this good news. But now, because you did not believe my words, which will be fulfilled in their time, you will become mute, unable to speak, until the day these things occur.

Meanwhile the people were waiting for Zechariah, and wondered at his delay in the sanctuary. When he did come out, he could not speak to them, and they realised that he had seen a vision in the sanctuary. He kept motioning to them and remained unable to speak. When his time of service was ended, he went to his home. After those days his wife Elizabeth conceived, and for five months she remained in seclusion. She said, "This is what months she remained in seclusion. She said, the Lord has done for me when he looked favourably on me and took away the disgrace I have endured among my people.

Light from the Word - Announcement to Zechariah



This Sunday we commence our preparation for Christmas, according our Maronite to Lectionary. The stories of the Gospels will unfold over the Sunday's ahead, depicting the events leading up to the birth of Jesus. Today we enter the lives of Zechariah and Elizabeth.

Zechariah is told his aging and barren wife, Elizabeth, would bear him a son, John the Baptist. Such an unexpected turn of events leaves Zechariah dumbfounded, literally! As the angel declared, 'You will become mute, unable to speak, until the day these things occur'v20. So Zechariah was left to ponder in silence what

glories God was preparing.

Interestingly when Elizabeth discovers she is with child, she too goes into silence, 'After these days his wife Elizabeth conceived, and for five months she remained in seclusion'v24. It is worth adding here, that Mary, as we see in later chapters, was also known to enter into silence, 'But Mary treasured all these words and pondered them in her heart' (2:19).

We tend to celebrate Christmas with toys and tinsel, grand meals and chatter, blinking lights and Christmas carols. Yet the events leading up to the bursting forth of God Incarnate, were quiet, hidden events.

Silence carries with it mystery. It breathes the dreams of people and pulsates with God's presence. This time leading up to Christmas, is about birthing new life. Just like God spent nine months in a dark, silent womb, we too must learn that times of silence are times of new birthing, new insights and new possibilities.

God is best known in our very depths. So let us stop and wait and allow the wonder of God's Spirit to surprise us with hope. Amen

Saint of the Week ST CECILIA, MARTYR **22 November**

- Cecilia was a Roman girl of patrician family, who had been brought up as a Christian in a time of rough persecution of Christians
- Although she wished to remain a virgin, her father betrothed her to a young pagan named Valerian;
- She aided in the conversion of Valerian and his brothers and they became devout Christians who were martyred for their faith;
- When Cecilia was found to be a Christian. orders where given for her to be suffocated in her own bathroom. Surviving this attempt on her life, a soldier was sent to behead her. He struck at her neck three times, then left her lying, still alive, for it was against the law to strike a fourth time;
- She remained alive for three days, during which the Christians who remained in Rome flocked to her house. In dying she bequeathed all her goods to the poor, and her house to the bishop for a Christian place of worship. She was buried in the crypt of the Caecilii at the catacomb of St. Callistus.

Profiles of the Christmas Characters **Zechariah**



The announcement of the birth of the forerunner, John the Baptist, to Zechariah who was a high priest, signals God's renewed activity on behalf of his people in light of promises made long ago. As a starting point Zechariah and Elizabeth set a perfect example of how we should be living our life. They were righteous, pious, devout law-abiding, religious, walking blamelessly in all the commandments and requirements of God.

That is not to say that Zechariah and Elizabeth had no problems. While many of our problems stem from our own sins, God does allow some to invade our lives for no other purpose but to help us grow. He wants them there, and no amount of obedience can possibly bring immunity from them until God is prepared to reveal his salvation to us. Zechariah could have at the time submitted to the cultural

accepted tradition of divorcing Elizabeth because of their disappointment and disgrace of barrenness especially with his status as a priest, but that did not stop them, they were **counter cultural** and submitted to the will of God and obeyed the Word of God with all humility, **simplicity** and praising **service** to Him with a **smile**. God wants husbands out in front, taking the spiritual lead and ministering to their wives and children in the things of Christ. Calling them to be counter cultural and to look at our hardships as an opportunity for blessing and to devoutly continue in service to God and others.

The quality of our walk with God determines our ability to walk happily and harmoniously with each other. And that walk with God can only grow as we seek to please Him rather than impress men highlighted by the fact that Zechariah chose God and the name John in a family feud.

In this way as people of the faith we can see that our faith should not weaken like Zachariah's who questioned the angel of God no matter how hopeless the situation is we should not bail out on God. It is so much easier to quit and run away from difficult circumstances, but that usually compounds the problem. Maybe you think that God has forgotten you in your hopeless situation. God can solve all our problems however some will invariably protest and say: "But you don't understand. My situation is impossible." "My husband will never change." My wife will never learn." "We'll never get out of debt." "I'll never be well again." "My unsaved loved one will never come to know Christ." "This job will never improve." Listen to God's Word again: "For with God nothing shall be impossible." Believe that. Obey him. Then keep on keeping on.

God hasn't forgotten us. Our God is the God of the impossible as much today as he was over 2000 years ago. He delights in doing impossible things for us when He knows we shall give Him the glory. God wants us to take our difficulties to Him in prayer together, search the Word together for encouragement and direction, and then wait patiently in reflective **Silence** for Him to work rather than gossip and talk about others. So don't chafe and agonize under the burden. Believe him. Keep on faithfully living for Him and patiently waiting for Him to work, just as Zechariah and Elizabeth did knowing that God's answers to prayer come in surprising ways and sometimes after a long time. Also remember that God does not always give according to our asking, and certainly not according to our deserving. He gives according to the riches of His grace. He does "exceeding abundantly beyond all that we ask or think.

Our mission and Vocation in the Kingdom of God

Each baptised Christian has a particular task or mission in contributing to the bringing about and further developing the Kingdom of God. This is our vocation, a vocation of love and service of God and his people. In discerning our vocation we remember that God speaks to the person in many ways (scripture, liturgy, church teachings etc.). What we must always remember however is that our vocation and mission is never forced upon us, rather God calls us to cooperate with his graciousness to be able to fulfil our mission and vocation. In the case of Zechariah, God spoke to him through the angel Gabriel but Zechariah's response was influenced by fear and the "science" of his situation. His time in silence allowed him to see that whilst the "science" of his situation was clearly correct, God is all loving and all powerful and he need not fear but trust in God's providence and love. Zechariah's cooperation with God (which we will hear about in 3 weeks on Sunday of the Birth of John the Baptist), leads him to finally accept the message of God via Gabriel, thus he is able to speak again. However Zechariah doesn't just speak in normal terms again, his first words are that of praising God and his glory in his canticle of praise known as the Benedictus (Luke 1:68-79). In our own response to God's call, we must always aim to reply with joy, faithfulness and above all, love. In our lives of prayer, may we be attentive to the invitations God places before us and respond with joy, faith and love. May we remain humble servants of the gracious God who calls us and allows us to play our small part in salvation history through our mission in bringing about and developing the Kingdom of God , this kingdom which is here and now, the kingdom of God's holy Church.


Children's Corner

في هذا الأحد، أحد بشارة زكريا، تدعونا الكنيسة، لندخل إذاً في منطق الإيمان المستند إلى الرّجاء، في كلّ الأحوال، لأنّ الربّ حاضرٌ معنا ومن أجلنا، كلّما رفعنا إليه قلوبنا بخوراً مرضياً أمام مذبح قلب حنانه، (معنى يوحنا = الله تحنّن!)

"لا تكونوا سببًا للعثرات، واظبوا على الغفران وآمنوا"



"على كل مسيحي مهما كانت دعوته أن يقدم على الغفران من دون أن يكون سببًا للعثرات لأنّ العثرات تدمّر الإيمان" هذا ما طلبه البابا فرنسيس. "لا محالة من وجود أسباب العثرات ولكن الويل لمن تأتي عن يده فلأن تُعلَّق الرحى في عنقه ويُلقى في البحر أولى به من أن يكون حجر عثرة لأحد هؤلاء الصغار". انطلق البابا فرنسيس من ثلاث كلمات وردت في إنجيل لوقا (17: 1-6) وهي العثرة والغفران والإيمان مبتدئًا بالقول "الويل لمن تقع على يده العثرات" مشيرًا إلى التوجيهات التي يقدّمها القديس بولس في رسالته طيطس (1: 1-9) حول الأسقف بألاّ يكون غضوبًا أو شرسًا أو ... بمعنى آخر ألاّ يكون غير محبوب من الناس.

وركز على فكرة العثرات التي يقوم بها المسيحيون إذ يقولون بإنهم مسيحيون ويعيشون عيشة الوثنية وقال: "عندما يذهب مسيحي أو مسيحية إلى الكنيسة ولا يعيش وفق تعاليمها فإنه يكون حجر عثرة وكم من المرات نسمع أشخاصًا يقولون بإنهم لا يذهبون إلى الكنيسة مفضلين أن يكونوا صريحين مع أنفسهم فلا يكونون مثل أؤلئك الذين يذهبون ويتصرّفون عكس ما يسمعون". وأضاف: "إنّ العثرات تدمّر! إنها تدمّر الإيمان ولهذا يسوع تحدّث عنها بنبرة حادة: "خذوا الحذر لأنفسكم! خذوا الحذر لأنفسكم! ومن المفيد اليوم أن ننظر نحن إلى أنفسنا وننتبه لئلاً نصدم الآخرين بتصرفاتنا." وتابع البابا: "وبالطريقة نفسها وليس العكس، نحن مدعوون لأن نتعلّم أن نغفر. وأن نغفر "دائمًا" مشددًا على ما قاله يسوع الذي يدعو أن نغفر سبع مرات في اليوم إذا ما خطىء إلينا أخونا.

وقال البابا: "إنّ يسوع يبالغ بغية إفهامنا أهمية الغفران لأنّ المسيحي الذي لا يقدر أن يغفر يكون حجر عثرة أمام أخيه وبالتالي ليس مسيحيًا."

وأضاف: "علينا أن نغفر لأنّ الغفران يرد في الصلاة التي علّمنا إياها يسوع في صلاة الأبانا. إنّ المنطق البشري لا يستطيع أن يفهم ذلك فيدفعنا إلى عدم الغفران وإلى الانتقام ويقودنا إلى الكراهية والانقسام. كم من العائلات هي منقسمة بسبب عدم الغفران: كم من العائلات! وكم من الأبناء يعيشون بعيدًا عن أهلهم أو ينفصل الزوج عن الزوجة ... من المهم جدًا أن نفكر في هذا الأمر. يبدو أنه حين لا أجيد الغفران لا أفهم ما معنى أنّ الرب غفر لي. وهذه الكلمة الثانية: الغفران." وختم البابا: "من هنا نفهم إذًا لمَ سأل الرسل يسوع "زينا إيمانًا" لأنه من دون الإيمان لا يمكننا أن نعيش من دون العثرات والغفران الدائم. وحده من خلال نور الإيمان، الإيمان الذي تلقيناه من الأب الرحيم، من ابن بذل نفسه من أجلنا، من روح ساكن فينا ويساعدنا على النمو، من إيمان الكنيسة ومن إيمان شعب الله المعمدين والقديسين. إنها لنعمة، إنّ الإيمان هو عطية مُنحت لنا ."


