The Gospel

Fourth Sunday of the Resurrection

The Epistle

After these things Jesus showed himself again to the disciples by the Sea of Tiberias; and he showed himself in this way. Gathered there together were Simon Peter, Thomas called the Twin, Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, the sons of Zebedee, and two others of his disciples. Simon Peter said to them, "I am going fishing." They said to him, "We will go with you." They went out and got into the boat, but that night they caught nothing. Just after daybreak, Jesus stood on the beach; but the disciples did not know that it was Jesus. Jesus said to them, "Children, you have no fish, have you?" They answered him, "No." He said to them, "Cast the net to the right side of the boat, and you will find some." So they cast it, and now they were not able to haul it in because there were so many fish. That disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord!"

When Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put on some clothes, for he was naked, and jumped into the sea. But the other disciples came in the boat, dragging the net full of fish, for they were not far from the land, only about a hundred yards off. When they had gone ashore, they saw a charcoal fire there, with fish on it, and bread. Jesus said to them, "Bring some of the fish that you have just caught." So Simon Peter went aboard and hauled the net ashore, full of large fish, a hundred fifty-three of them; and though there were so many, the net was not torn. Jesus said to them, "Come and have breakfast."

Now none of the disciples dared to ask him, "Who are you?" because they knew it was the Lord. Jesus came and took the bread and gave it to them, and did the same with the fish. This was now the third time that Jesus appeared to the disciples after he was raised from the dead.

Awakened to life

The Catechism How does the Virgin Mary help the Church?

In this Sunday's Gospel passage we have an encounter with the risen Jesus by the Sea of Tiberias, and slowly the call to resume life begins to be heard by those grieving.

Simon Peter decides to go fishing and his is accompanied by six other disciples. His call to go fishing was most likely an excuse, more than a necessity. Yes, they probably needed to fish in order to eat, but how much of an appetite does a grieving person have? Going fishing was probably a way to get out onto the lake, to be left alone, to have the time to ponder over past events.

The fishing expedition is unsuccessful as we read, 'that night they caught nothing' (v3). However, that didn't deter them. Perhaps they were content for now just to sit in that boat, in the dark, on the lake, away from reality. They remain at a distance, until daybreak. Then Jesus appears.

When instructed by Jesus to cast the net one more time, the haul of fish is significant. Suddenly the disciples are wakened from their stupor. Jesus has jolted them back into the world where there is fish to be caught, work to be done, mouths to feed and it is business as usual. The distaste for life that accompanies grief, sooner or later, is left behind for the demands of everyday life. Life must be lived.

Jesus reminds the disciples the joy of a good catch, the pleasure of sharing a meal as he prepares them breakfast, and the memories that are made as one gathers with good company. Jesus returns after death, not to condemn, but to remind us that life is worth living abundantly. Amen

In what sense is the Blessed Virgin Mary the Mother of the Church? The Blessed Virgin Mary is the Mother of the Church in the order of grace because she gave birth to Jesus, the Son of God, the Head of the body which is the Church.  $m{B}$ rothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our Lord appears for the third time after his Resurrection in this week's Gospel passage. The apostles had gone back to their normal jobs after the recent events that had taken place. They were angry, confused and hopeless and to make matters worse, even their job as fishermen was not giving them any satisfaction because they were unable to catch any fish. Jesus, having seen that they had not caught a thing, suggested to throw the net on the other side of the boat. At this stage, he was still unknown to them. Having nothing to lose, they did just as he suggested. Shocked by such a huge large catch, they put the pieces of the puzzle together and

recognized the person on the shore to be Jesus. Peter in his usual sporadic fashion, instantaneously dived into the water and swam while the others returned to shore and all responded to Jesus' request to eat together.

This scene connected the post-resurrected Jesus with the one they had lived with for the last three years. He ate fish. He knew them in and out. Jesus not only arose but was meeting with them as before. But more than proof of a physical resurrection, we see Jesus' commitment to communion with them and his desire to continue to work with them. The Apostles can do nothing of worth on their own - not even catch a fish, and with gentleness the Lord reminds them that with him, they can do the impossible. This is our story too! We tend to lock ourselves up in our own little world, just like the Apostles did, and only later do we come to realize that there is someone missing - the Lord. The Lord will not allow any barriers to get in his way. He will reveal himself, one way or another, and not allow any of his sheep to wander too far off. Therefore, when we too are angry, confused and have lost hope, we must also remember that we can do nothing of worth without Jesus. He is our hope and our strength and it is only through him and with him that we too can do the impossible.

The month of May home visits continue this week with Our Lady. It has been beautiful to see families gathering together in prayer. We need to encourage this not only during this month, but every day of our lives. This coming week we will be honouring our mothers on Tuesday 9 May beginning at 10.30am with a Mass and then a luncheon in the Cathedral Hall. Please don't miss out on buying a ticket for your mother. On Friday 12 May, the Novena to Saint Rita begins after the 6pm Mass. We will be praying for the persecuted Christians in Egypt this year through the intercession of Saint Rita. On Saturday 13 May at 9am, our brothers and sisters from the Latin Rite will be joining us to celebrate 100 years of the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima. We will start here at the Cathedral with morning prayers, then process with the statue of Our Lady of Fatima to Saint Patrick's Cathedral in Parramatta, where we will celebrate Mass and have lunch together. I look forward to seeing you all at these events.

A couple of years ago whilst working on a new construction site, I had the owner of the house approach me and ask "aren't you becoming a priest"? Surprised by his question I began to explain that I was discerning and was open to whatever God willed. Having never recognized this man at church I started having a chat with my boss about how important it is to be mindful of our actions in our everyday lives. What if I was carrying on and swearing? Or what if I was getting angry and being rude with fellow workers? What impression of a Christian would I have given this man whom I had never recognized before?

A few years ago, I was far from the church. I was caught up in drugs, alcohol, nightclubs and gambling. Quite often I would be seen in nightclubs intoxicated and high on drugs. I wonder what impression I had on people back then? More importantly, what kind of image would I give someone if they seen me doing that today? Would they say, "that's the altar server from Our Lady"? Would I be leading them to Christ or destruction? Brothers and sisters I urge you to never underestimate the consequence of your actions and how they effect the people around you. Jesus said, "Let your light shine before men so that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven". (Matt 5:16)

• Dur actions- whether good or bad- influence the people around us and may cause others to sin or encourage them to be virtuous. Throughout my spiritual life, I've come to understand that the best way to preach the gospel is to live it. We can tell others that they need God or we can show others our love for God. We can tell people about the necessity of prayer or we can show others our love for prayer.

I pray that God may continue to guide us so that we may go out and bring Jesus into this dark world so that His love may enlighten the hearts of all men.





"سنة الشهادة والشهداء"

الشهيد هو المتماهي مع المسيح الذي اقتدى به وامتلأ من قوة الروح القدس ونعمة الآب، ليزف بإراقة دمه بشرى الإنجيل. ويشهد لإيمانه المسيحي بالآب والابن والروح القدس ولانتمائه الكنسي، ولتعلّقه بالفضائل الإلهيّة وبتعليم الكنيسة، ويواجه بأدوات السلام والرحمة سيف المضطّهد الذي يعذّبه ويقتله بوسائل شتّى.

الاستشهاد هو فعل يقوم به الشهيد على إشهار شهادة إيمانه بالمسيح وحبّه له بحرّية وصدقيّة وفرح، راغبًا في الاقتداء الكامل بالمسيح والاشتراك في تدبيره الخلاصي. إنّه يسترجع في قرارة نفسه كلام الربّ: "إن اضطهدوني فسوف يضطهدونكم أيضًا" (يو ١٥: ٢٠). ليس الاستشهاد المسيحي سعيًا إلى الموت بل هو الثبات على الإيمان بالمسيح حتى الموت (راجع متى ١٠: ٣٢٢).


في تراثنا الانطاكي، نقرأ لاهوت الشهادة والاستشهاد في روحانيّة القدِّيس اغناطيوس الانطاكي الذي كان يعتبر أنّ شهادة الدَّم هي دعوة خاصّة من الله في الكنيسة واختيار إلهي، وأنّها إفخارستيًا معاشة. هكذا كتب إلى أهل روما: "دعوني أصيرُ طعامًا للوحوش، فإني بواسطتها أصل إلى الله. أنا حنطة الله،

تطحنني أنياب الحيوانات لأصير خبزًا للمسيح خاليًا من كلّ عيب... إسألوا المسيح أن يتنازل ويجعل منّي ذبيحةً لله بواسطة أنياب الوحوش" (إلى الرومانيين ٤: ١). وكان يعتبر أنّ الاستشهاد هو فرصة لشهادة أقوى للمسيح فكتب: "اكتفوا بأن تسألوا لي القوّة الداخليّة والخارجيّة لأكون مسيحيًا لا بالكلام بل بالقلب، لا اسمًا فحسب بل فعلًا. وعندما أغيب عن هذا العالم يظهر إيماني بكلّ ضيائه" (إلى الرومانيين ٣: ١). وإلى أهل إزمير كتب: "شهادة الدّم تُظهر حياة المسيح فينا، وتشهد للقيامة وللانتصار على الموت منذ الآن" (إزمير ٣). 


مع يسوع يصبح المستحيل ممكناً!



قَالَ يُوحِنَّا الرَّسُولِ: بَعْدَ ذلك، ظَهَرَ يَسُوعُ لِتَلامِيذِهِ مَرَّةً أُخْرَى عَلى بُحَيْرة طَبَرَيَّة، وهكذا ظَهر: كَانَ سِمْعَانُ بُطْرُس، وتُومَ المُلَقَّبُ بالتَّوْأَم، ونَتَنَائِيلُ الَّذي مِنْ قَانَا الجَلِيل، وابْنَا زَبَدَى، وتِلْمِيذَان آخَرَان مِنْ تَلامِيذِ يَسُوع، مُجْتَمِعِينَ مَعًا. قَالَ لَهُم سِمْعَانُ بُطْرُسِ: "أَنَا ذَاهِبٌ أَصْطَادُ سَمَكًا". قَالُوا لَهُ: "ونَحْنُ أَيْضًا نَأْتِي مَعَكَ". فَخَرَجُوا وَرَكِبُوا السَّفِينَة، فَمَا أَصَابُوا في تِلْكَ اللَّيْلَةِ شَيْئًا. ولَمَّا طَلَعَ الفَجْر، وَقَفَ يَسُوعُ عَلَى الشَّاطِئ، ولكِنَّ التَّلامِيذَ لَمْ يَعْلَمُوا أَنَّهُ يَسُوع. فَقَالَ لَهُم يَسُوع: "يَا فِتْيَان، أَمَا عِنْدَكُم شَيْءٌ يُؤْكَل ؟". أَجَابُوهِ: "لا!". فَقَالَ لَهُم: "أَلْقُوا الشَّبَكةَ إلى يَمِينِ السَّفِينَةِ تَجدُوا". وأَلقَوْهَا، فَمَا قَدِرُوا عَلى اجْتِذَابِهَا مِنْ كَثْرُةِ السَّمَك. فَقَالَ ذَلِكَ التِّلْمِيذُ الَّذِي كَانَ يَسُوعُ يُحِبُّهُ لِبُطْرُس: "إنَّهُ الرَبِّ". فَلَمَّا سَمِعَ سِمْعَانُ بُطْرُسُ أَنَّهُ الرَبِّ، إِتَّزَرَ بِثَوْبِهِ، لأنَّهُ كَانَ عُرْيَانًا، وأَلْقَى بِنَفْسِهِ في البُحَيْرَة. أَمَّا التَّلامِيذُ الآخَرُونَ فَجَاؤُوا بِالسَّفِينَة، وهُمْ يَسْحَبُونَ الشَّبَكَةَ المَمْلُوءَ ةَ سَمَكًا، ومَا كَانُوا بَعِيدِينَ عَنِ النِّرِّ إلاَّ نَحْوَ مِنَّتَى ذِرَاع. ولَمَّا نَزَلُوا إلى البَرّ، رَأُوا جَمْرًا، وسَمَكًا عَلى الجَمْر، وخُبْزًا. قَالَ لَهُم يَسُوع: "هَاتُوا مِنَ السَّمَكِ الَّذي أَصَبْتُمُوهُ الآن". فَصَعِدَ سِمْعَانُ بُطْرُسُ إلى السَّفِينَة، وجَذَبَ الشَّبَكَةَ إلى البَرّ، وهي مَمْلُوءَ ةٌ سَمَكًا كَبِيرًا، مِئَةً وتَلاثًا وخَمْسِين. ومَعَ هذه الكَثْرَة لَمْ تَتَمَزَّقِ الشَّبَكَةِ. قَالَ لَهُم يَسُوع: "هَلُمُوا تَغَدُّوا". ولَمْ يَجْرُؤُ أَحَدٌ مِنَ التَّلامِيذِ أَنْ يَسْأَلَهُ: "مَنْ أَنْت؟"، لأَنَّهُم عَلِمُوا أَنَّهُ الرَبِّ. وتَقَدَّمَ يَسُوعُ وأَخَذَ الخُبْزَ وِنَاوَلَهُم. ثُمَّ فَعَلَ كَذلِكَ بِالسَّمَكِ. هذه مَرَّةٌ ثَالِثَةٌ ظَهَرَ فيهَا يَسُوعُ لِلتَّلامِيذِ بَعْدَ أَنْ قَامَ مِنْ بَيْنِ الأَمْوَاتِ.
