Gospel According to Matthew

Immediately he made the disciples get into the boat and go on ahead to the other side, while he dismissed the crowds. But when he noticed the strong wind,[b] he became frightened, and beginning to sink, he cried out, "Lord, save me!" Jesus immediately reached out his hand and caught him, saying to him, "You of little faith, why did you doubt?" When they got into the boat, the wind ceased. And those in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God."
