When I came to you, brothers and sisters, I did not come proclaiming the mystery of God to you in lofty words or wisdom. Light from the word



Today's Gospel Reading comes from the farewell discourses in John's Gospel. In this short passage we are invited to the love of God.

The word love appears no less than seven times and it

should come as no surprise given Jesus' new commandment was to love one another as he loved us (Jn 13:34). In the early church Christians were recognised neither by the crosses they wore around their necks nor the rosary beads they possessed. Rather Christians were known by their love for one another. To be a Christian was to live it out through actions and words of love, not, as unfortunately we see today, simply through external wear and public talks.

The other major characteristic of being a Christian that emerges from today's Reading is peace, the peace that is given by Jesus. It removes all trouble and fear. Peace offers the Christian hope and a gentle attitude to life.

So unlike the strivings of many to achieve comfort, wealth, admiration or power, the quest of a Christian is for God. The means to God is through words and deeds of love. We are assisted on our journey through the grace of the Holy Spirit and the peace of Christ. Such presence and gifts empower us to be disciples of Christ, messengers of love and ambassadors of peace. Saint Aquilina of Jbeil JUNE 13



St. Aquilina, a native of the Phoenician city of Byblos, suffered under Emperor Diocletian in the third century. She was raised in Christian piety by her parents. When she was only twelve years old, she persuaded a pagan friend to convert to Christ. One of the servants of Governor Volusian accused her of teaching others to reject paganism. She was taken before the governor where she firmly confessed her belief and said that she

would not renounce Him. Volusian tried to influence her through persuasion and flattery, but seeing her confidence, he ordered her to be tortured.

She was struck upon the face, and then stripped and beaten with whips. Her torturers asked, "Where then is your God? Let Him come and take you out of our hands." But the saint answered, "The Lord is here with me invisibly, and the more I suffer, the more strength and endurance will He give me."

Heated metal rods were then drilled through her ears, and St. Aquilina fell down as if dead. The torturers thought that she had actually died, and gave orders that her body be thrown outside the city to be eaten by dogs. However, later that night, a Holy angel appeared to St Aquilina, roused her and said, "Arise and be healed. Go and denounce Volusian, so that he and his plans may come to nothing."

The next morning he sentenced St. Aquilina to death, saying that she was a sorceress who refused his imperial decrees. While being led to her execution, St. Aquilina prayed and gave thanks to God for allowing her to suffer for His Holy Name.

A voice was heard in answer to her prayer, summoning her to the Heavenly Kingdom. Before the executioner could carry out the sentence, the martyr gave up her spirit to God. Christians piously buried the martyr's body. Later, her relics were taken to Constantinople and placed in a church named in her honor.

Shepherd's Corner - "Where are the Equal Rights of Children?"



Dear Parishioners,

Regarding the change in the definition in marriage there are different reasons why people hold to the views of traditional marriage.

There are reasons from our Catholic faith perspective, defending the sanctity of marriage. However there are also reasons from a non-Christian perspective and the two overlap in areas. To be effective voices of truth in these modern times we need to be aware of both of these and the appropriate audience to express them.

The faith perspective reasons are for Catholics and Christians who might agree with changing the meaning of marriage. The non – faith reasons are for all, and especially for those who don't believe in God.

The Catholic faith perspective arguments are included in our Bishop's Message (Feature article) and the Pastoral Letter of the Australian Catholic Bishop's titled "Don't Mess with Marriage" which you can find easily online at https://www.catholic.org.au/acbc-media/media-centre/media-releases-new/1687-same-sex-marriage-pastoral-letter-web-version.

The central reason and not necessarily faith based is: Where are the "Rights of Children" in this "Equal Rights for same sex marriage" debate? Do these "equal rights" include the right to for "same sex couples" to have and raise children? If so what about the natural and psychological rights of children to be raised by a mum and dad? This is a core issue for the long term good of humanity. You just need to read the articles now coming out about the long term effects on children with same sex parents (for example: http://www.thepublicdiscourse.com/2015/04/14899/). Marriage ensures the well-being of children. Every child has the right to a mum and a dad whenever possible. Children do best with two biological parents The so called drive for equality should not outweigh the right of children to be raised by a dad and a mum for the optimum of developmental wellbeing.

In approaching this issue we must place the issue before our Lord in prayer and ask for the guidance of the Holy Spirit. We must grow in our knowledge on the issues involved and equip ourselves to listen, dialogue and promote the truth with love to all those around us. Yes write to your Federal Member of Parliament. (See Bishop's Article). We must rid ourselves of all unchristian and homophobic attitudes and language towards people of same sex attraction. Finally and very importantly all married couples and parents must be prepared to renew the gift of their faith in God and grow in that faith in our Maronite Parish, living out the sacred and wonderful calling of their marriage with their God-given mission to be parents leading their children and grandchildren to experience family as truly a "domestic church", a dwelling place of the Holy Trinity.

Bishop's Article - federal push for same sex marriage



My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

A bipartisan Bill to change the federal definition of marriage in the Marriage Act 1961 is expected to be introduced into Federal Parliament early next week and may be voted into law immediately following its introduction.

I urge you to make your views on marriage known to your local Federal Member of Parliament.

Please share with them what marriage means to you and your family and ask them to uphold the true meaning of marriage as the mutual love of a man and a woman, open to the gift of children.

If you are not sure which electorate you live in, please visit Find My Electorate

(http://apps.aec.goc.au/esearch/) and enter your postcode. If you live outside New South Wales, please visit the Australian Christian Lobby webpage Your Voice is Needed to find your local Federal MP.

Members of Parliament have advised the Life, Marriage and Family Centre in the Catholic Archdiocese of Sydney that that the most helpful lobbying they can receive at this stage is an email from their constituents. In particular, if your MP is listed as "UNCERTAIN" (www.lifemarriagefamily.org.au) in his or her position on marriage, a personal email to him/her would be especially helpful.

The Catholic Bishops of Australia have just released a special pastoral letter to the faithful, Don't Mess With Marriage, You may wish to use some of the material from the letter to help you formulate your email to your MP.

Some further brief points which may be helpful for your email:

- 1. The Commonwealth Marriage Act 1961 recognises the truth that marriage is "a union of a man and a woman, to the exclusion of all others, voluntarily entered into for life". The enduring meaning of marriage was upheld in 2012 when same presex marriage bills were rejected decisively by both the Federal House of Representatives and the Senate.
- 2. The mutual love of a man and woman, and their physical complementarity, provides the natural and vital community for procreation. The reason the state has recognised marriage and distinguishes it from other types of relationships is because of its unique capacity to generate children and to meet children's deepest needs for the love, attachment and nurturing of both their father and their mother.
- 3. Changing the meaning of marriage is socially divisive and is not the proper role of government.
- 4. If the Federal Parliament legislates for same-sex marriage, it will abandon any principled basis for rejecting further demands for "marriage equality" from other persons who wish their relationships to be recognised as marriages, e.g. multiple-partner unions.
- 5. Children as a group are the most powerless in our society, but they are the ones with the greatest investment in marriage continuing to be understood as the union of a man and a woman. A stable, loving marriage provides the best environment for raising children, because it gives them the greatest possible chance of being loved and raised by their biological mother and father.
- 6. At a time when marriage in our society is already under pressure, we should be doing what we can to support marriage, not undermine it.
- 7. When the meaning of marriage is changed, it is changed for everyone. The experience of countries which have legalised same-sex marriage shows us that the freedom of ordinary men and women to live, teach and publicly profess their belief that marriage is the union of a man and a woman will become more and more restricted, and even subject to legal action and penalties.

Please email your local Federal MP this weekend to let them know this issue of marriage is of great importance to you and your family, and will be a crucial consideration in casting your vote at the next federal parliamentary election in 2016.

Thank you for your ongoing support for sanctity and institution of marriage.

"في الفشل ينتصر حب الله"

"كم من المرات نقول ليسوع "إبتعد عنا" ولا نعترف بفشلنا. ولكنّ "انتصار محبة الله" للإنسان تتكشف "بوضوح" في صليب ابنه. هذا ما تحدث عنه اليوم البابا فرنسيس في أثناء عظته الصباحية من دار القديسة مارتا معلّقًا على مثل الكرّامين القتلة.

الحجر الذي رذله البناؤون صار رأس الزاوية. الله يبني على ضعفنا ولكن إذا قرأ أحدنا "تاريخ الحب الذي جمع الله وشعبه يجد بأنه يبدو دائمًا وكأنه قصة فشل". انطلق البابا من إنجيل القديس مرقس (١٠: ١ – ١٢) وفيه يتحدّث عن فرح الله وهو صاحب الكرم حفر معصرة وبنى برجًا فيه إنما بعد أن أوكل الكرم للكرّامين كانوا يضربون العبد الموكل من صاحب الكرم في كل مرة... حتى وصل بهم الأمر لأن يقتلوا ابنه الوحيد



من هنا الأب الأقدس أشار الى أنّه من خلال الموت يجد الجميع الحياة.

وقال: "إنّ الأنبياء هم رجال الله الذي يكلّمون الشعب الأصمّ عن كلمة الله والذي تاه بعيدًا عنه. وأما الإبن وهو الشخص الأخير الذي تم إرساله قد حُكم عليه ولم يسمعه أحد وقتلوه ولكن هو نفسه أصبح حجر الزاوية. إنّ هذه القصة التي تبدأ بحلم حب وتابع ليكون تاريخ من الحب والذي يبدو للكثيرين بأنه تاريخ من الفشل ينتهي في الواقع بحب عظيم حيث يرسل الله ابنه الوحيد ليخلّص العالم".

وتابع الأب الأقدس ليشير الى أنّ كل الكتاب المقدس يحوي أحداثًا تبيّن مدى حب الله لشعبه بالرغم من تمرّد هذا الأخير وعصيانه. وإنّ مسيرة الخلاص هي مسيرة تخللها الكثير من الفشل. حتى في الختام عند الصليب بالرغم من أنه يبدو للكثيرين بأنه محطة فشل انتصر الحب عنده وهذه القصة التي تبدأ بحلم محبة تتابع بتاريخ من الفشل وتتقهى بانتصار الحب: صليب يسوع المسيح".

"وإذا قام كل شخص منا بفحص ضمير سيرى كم من المرات أُبعد الأنبياء. كم من المرات قلنا ليسوع: "إذهب عنا" وكم من المرات أردنا أن نخلّص أنفسنا وظننا بأننا على حق".

ذكري بذرة الحب

ختم البابا: "لا تنسوا إذًا بأنّ في موت الإبن على الصليب ظهرت "محبة الله لشعبه". سيكون من الجيد أن نتذكّر قصة الحب التي تبدو وأنها فشلت ولكنها انتهت بالنصر. لقد زرع الله فينا بذرة المحبة ومن الضروري أن نتمثّل به من خلال التواضع".




